Here's the inside of the flower:

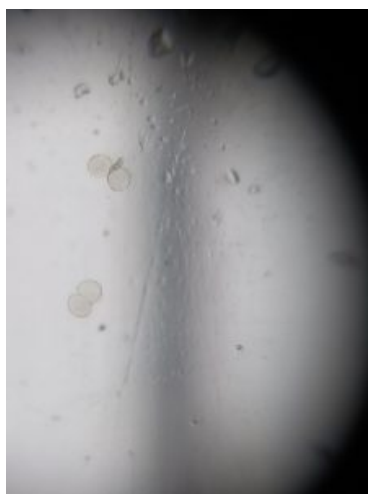


Heres its stamen:
